Disposal	Perpetrator is still outstanding for Arrest.
Rational	It is alleged that the suspect has punched the victim, grabbed and bent the fingers of the Victim and then banged her head against his car, causing a loss of consciousness. The Suspect has also punched the Victim's Son, 15yrs, causing no visible injuries. The Suspect is alleged to have previously choked the Victim. The suspect is suffering with an unknown mental health condition and allegedly uses cocaine and alcohol. The Victim is in fear of the suspect.  The victim and suspect have 7 previous recorded DA within Athena, 5 graded as Medium Risk and 2 as Standard Risk.  The Suspect has PNC Warning Markers for Violent, Mental Health, Suicidal and Self Harm.  The Suspect has previous convictions Violent offences, including Battery, Assault Police, Criminal Damage. The Suspect also has Non-Convictions/NFA's for the offences of Affray, Battery, Criminal Damage and Drunk & Disorderly.  These previous convictions, along with the previous recorded DA incidents, show a clear propensity to use violence, commit offences and breach orders imposed.
